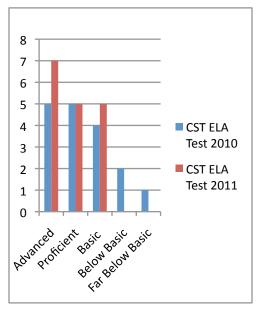

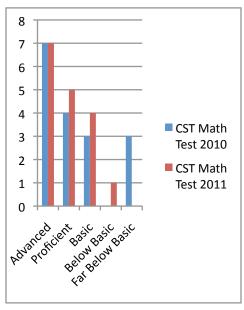

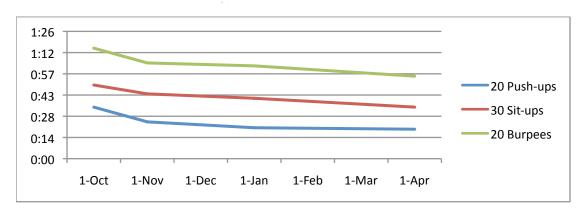


# **National Squash Rankings**

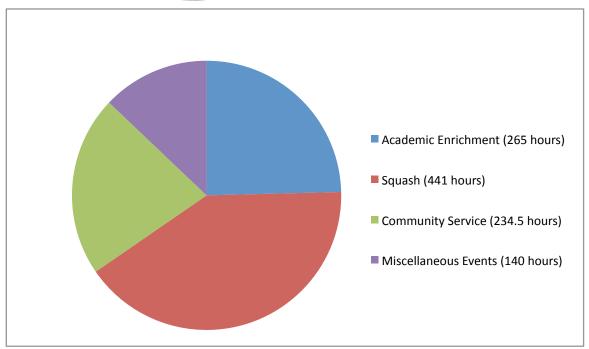


# **Community Service**

# What's ahead for the 2011-2012 School Year

- Tryouts will be held in September for the 2011-2012 school year
- We plan to add 9 new 5<sup>th</sup> graders to bring the total students to 30
- SBSOS plans to start a mentoring program to match mentors/mentees
